Privacy Statement

VOSSIUS & PARTNER Patentanwälte Rechtsanwälte mbB collects and processes your personal data according to the provisions of privacy law and of this privacy statement. In the following, you will be informed of the nature, extent and purpose of the collection and use of personal data. You can access this information at any time on our website.

Data transmission and logging for intrasystem and statistical purposes

For technical reasons, your internet browser automatically submits data to our web server whenever you access our website. This data includes, inter alia, the date and time of access, the URL of the referring website, the name of the accessed file, the amount of transmitted data, the browser type and version, the operating system and your IP address. This data is stored separately from other data you enter when using our website. We are unable to assign this information to a specific person. This data is analyzed exclusively for statistical purposes and subsequently deleted.

Master data

If a contractual relationship between you and our company is to be established, developed or modified, we collect and use your personal data to the extent necessary for this purpose. Processing of this data outside the European Economic Area (EEA) is possible if in compliance with the relevant provisions of privacy law.

On a case by case basis, we are permitted, upon request by the competent authorities, to disclose information pertaining to said data (master data) insofar as it is required for the purposes of law enforcement, hazard prevention, meeting the legal obligations of the authorities for the protection of the constitution or the military counterintelligence service, or asserting intellectual property rights.

Usage data

We collect and process your personal data to the extent necessary to allow the use of our website or, if applicable, for billing purposes. This includes, in particular, identifying personal data and information regarding the beginning and end as well as the extent of your use of our website.

We are permitted to create user profiles using pseudonyms for the purposes of advertising and market research and for adequately designing our web presence. You have the right to object to this use of your data. We are not permitted to amalgamate the user profiles and the data pertaining to the bearer of the pseudonym.

Contact form

You may contact us by using the contact form provided on our website. The data you fill in will be stored for the purpose of processing and answering your inquiries.

To ensure data security in the transmission of confidential data, we use an SSL encryption software.

Newsletter

On our website you have the possibility to order a free newsletter. The data collected via the contact form are sent to us after registering for the newsletter. These data are the following: first name, last name, e-mail address and country as well as the optional mention of company, zip code, city and potentially existing contact person at Vossius & Partner.

In addition, the following data is collected upon registration:

- (1) IP address of the calling computer
- (2) date and time of registration

For the processing of the data, your consent is obtained during the registration process and reference is made to this privacy policy.

In connection with the processing of data for the sending of newsletters, there is no disclosure of the data to third parties. The data will be used exclusively for sending the newsletter. The legal basis for the processing of the data after the user has registered for the newsletter is the consent of the user according to Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR.

The collection of the user's e-mail address serves to deliver the newsletter. The collection of other personal data in the context of the registration process serves to prevent misuse of the services or the email address used.

The data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer necessary for the purpose of its collection. The e-mail address of the user is therefore stored as long as the subscription to the newsletter is active. Other personal data collected during the registration process will normally be deleted after a period of seven days.

Subscription to the newsletter may be terminated at any time by the user concerned. For this purpose, there is a corresponding link in each newsletter. This also allows a revocation of the consent to the storage of the personal data collected during the registration process.

Cookies

We or respectively our website operator use so-called "cookies" to enhance the functionality and facilitate the use of our website. With the help of these cookies, data can be stored on your computer when you access our website. You have the option of preventing the storage of cookies on your computer by changing your browser settings accordingly. However, this may limit the functionality of our website.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called session cookies. These are deleted automatically at the end of your browser session. Other cookies remain on your device until these are deleted by yourself. These cookies enable us to recognize your browser at your next visit to our website.

Google Analytics

This website uses functions of Google Analytics, a web analytics service of Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA. Google Analytics also uses so-called cookies, i.e. text files which are stored on your computer and which help analyze how you use the website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website will usually be transmitted to and stored by Google on a server in the United States. However, if IP anonymization is activated on this website, your IP address is shortened by Google in the member states of the European Union or in other countries which are signatories to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases, the full IP address is transmitted to Google servers in the United States and then shortened. On behalf of the operator of this website, Google will use this information to evaluate your utilization of the website, to prepare reports about the activities on the website and to provide additional services to the operator of the website related to the utilization of the website and the use of the internet.

You may refuse the storage of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings in your browser software; however, please note that in this case you may not be able to use the full functionality of the website. You may also prevent the collection of the data referring to you that are generated by the cookie (including your IP address) in relation to the use of the website and the subsequent transfer to Google and the processing of these data by Google by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available at the following link: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout?hl=en>

Rights of individuals affected

As an individual affected, you are entitled to obtain from us information about the data stored about you and its source. Upon your request, the information may also be provided in electronic form.

You also have the right to demand that your personal data is corrected, deleted or blocked.

Approvals given by the individual affected, e.g. to receiving newsletters or to the storage of its personal data, may be revoked at any time.

Deletion of data

After expiration of its original purpose, we delete your personal data in compliance with the legal deletion periods and the rights of individuals affected, provided that no legitimate interest on our part or other legal provisions require otherwise.
